# Web Bonus: Halloween Table Runner **Monster Munchies**

#### Planning

This cute and friendly Halloween table runner features the Scribble Monsters II collection by Leeré Aldrich for Clothworks. This design is a great way to showcase any group of holiday fabrics and it's so quick, you can stitch it today for your party tonight!

### Fabric Requirements

Pumpkin print (center)	1 fat quarter*
Green eyes print, black bat print,	-
orange stripe, green bat print,	
black/gray check, <b>and</b> orange	
bat print (strips)	1⁄4 yd. <b>each</b>
Gray eyes print (squares)	1⁄8 yd.
Black/orange stripe (binding)	½ yd.
Backing	15⁄8 yds.
Batting size	22″ x 56″
*A fat quarter is an 18" x 20-22" cut of fabric.	

## Cutting Instructions (cut in order listed)


Pumpkin print 1 square 103/8" x 103/8" Green eyes print 2 strips 21/2" x 103/8" 2 strips 21/2" x 123/8" Gray eyes print 12 squares 21/2" x 21/2" Black bat print, orange stripe, green bat print, black/gray check, and orange bat print-cut from each: 4 strips 21/2" x 123/8" Black/orange stripe 4 strips  $2\frac{1}{2}$  x width of fabric (binding)





#### Piecing the Table Runner Top

 Referring to Diagram I, stitch together pumpkin print 10<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" square, 2 green eyes print 10<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" strips, and 1 gray eyes print 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" square.

Add 2 green eyes 123% strips and 1 gray eyes 21/2 square (**Diagram II**) to make pieced square.



**2** Referring to **Diagram III**, sew 2 black bat print 12<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" strips and 1 gray square to pieced square. In same manner, add 2 orange stripe 12<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" strips and 1 gray square.





In same manner, complete opposite end of table runner (**Diagram V**).



**3** Referring to **Diagram VI**, **trim** long sides of table runner <sup>1</sup>/4" outside corners of pumpkin square (trimmed edges should be approximately 7<sup>1</sup>/4" from inner point of gray squares).



#### Quilting & Finishing

4 Layer, baste, and quilt. Four straight lines are machine quilted in the center of the pumpkin square—2 diagonally and 1 each vertically and horizontally. The remainder of the table runner is quilted in the ditch. Bind with black/ orange stripe.

Continue adding strips and squares in fabrics shown to complete one end of table runner (**Diagram IV**).
