*Assorted cool prints
(Nine-Patch Blocks) 1-1¼ yds
total

*Assorted warm prints
(Nine-Patch Blocks,
Snowball Daisy Block
corners) 1¼-1½ yds.
total

White solid (Snowball Daisy
Block backgrounds) 1 yd.

12 assorted tone-on-tone
prints (petals) 10" x 10"
piece each

Green solid (daisy centers,
binding) ⅝ yd.

Paper-backed fusible web 1¾ yds.

Backing 3⅞ yds.

Batting size 52" x 52"

Note: Appliqué templates (at end of pattern) are printed without seam allowance to use with paper-backed fusible web.

Planning

Cheerful prints from the Honey, Honey collection by Kate Spain for Moda were the inspiration for Erin's fun little quilt. Erin placed cool colored prints (blues, aquas, and greens) in the corners and centers of her Nine-Patch Blocks. She used warm colored prints (pinks and oranges) on the sides of the Nine-Patch Blocks and corners of her Snowball Daisy Blocks. Erin used hand appliqué to create her blocks. Our instructions are for fast fusible appliqué.

Cutting Instructions

(cut in order listed, before cutting appliqué)

Note: Cutting instructions for appliqué shapes are on templates at end of pattern.

Assorted cool prints—cut a total of:

15 strips $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20-22"

Assorted warm prints—cut a total of:

12 strips $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20-22"

48 squares $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

White solid

12 squares $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ "

Green solid

6 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x width of fabric (binding)

Piecing the Blocks

1 Referring to **Diagram I-A**, sew together 2 assorted cool print and 1 assorted warm print $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20-22" strips to make strip set A. Make 6 total. Press in direction of arrows. Cut into 26 segments $3\frac{1}{2}$ " wide.

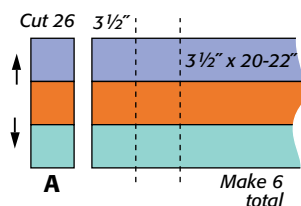

In same manner, use 2 assorted warm print and 1 assorted cool print $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20-22" strips to make strip set B (**Diagram I-B**). Make 3 total. Press, and cut into 13 segments $3\frac{1}{2}$ " wide.

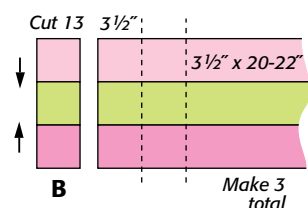

Sew together 2 A and 1 B segments to make Nine-Patch Block (**Diagram I-C**). Make 13 total.

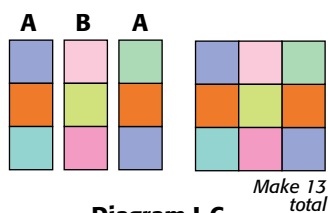

2 Draw diagonal line on wrong side of assorted warm print $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Referring to **Diagram II**, place marked square on white $9\frac{1}{2}$ " square, right sides together, aligning raw edges. Stitch on drawn line; trim away and discard excess fabric. Open and press. Repeat on remaining corners to make pieced square. Make 12 total.

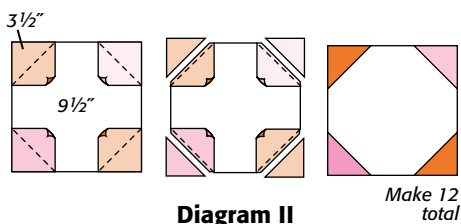

3 Follow manufacturer's instructions for paper-backed fusible web. Trace Templates A and B on paper side of fusible web. Cut apart, leaving small margin beyond drawn lines. Fuse to wrong side of appropriate fabrics; cut out on drawn lines.

Finger-press pieced square in half on both length and width; use folds as placement guide. Position A and B in alphabetical order (**Diagram III**). Fuse in place. Edge-stitch using machine blanket stitch to complete Snowball Daisy Block (**Diagram IV**). Make 12 total.

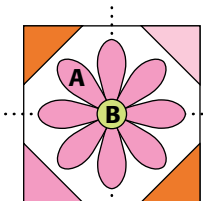

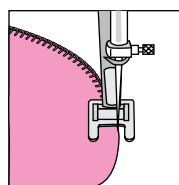
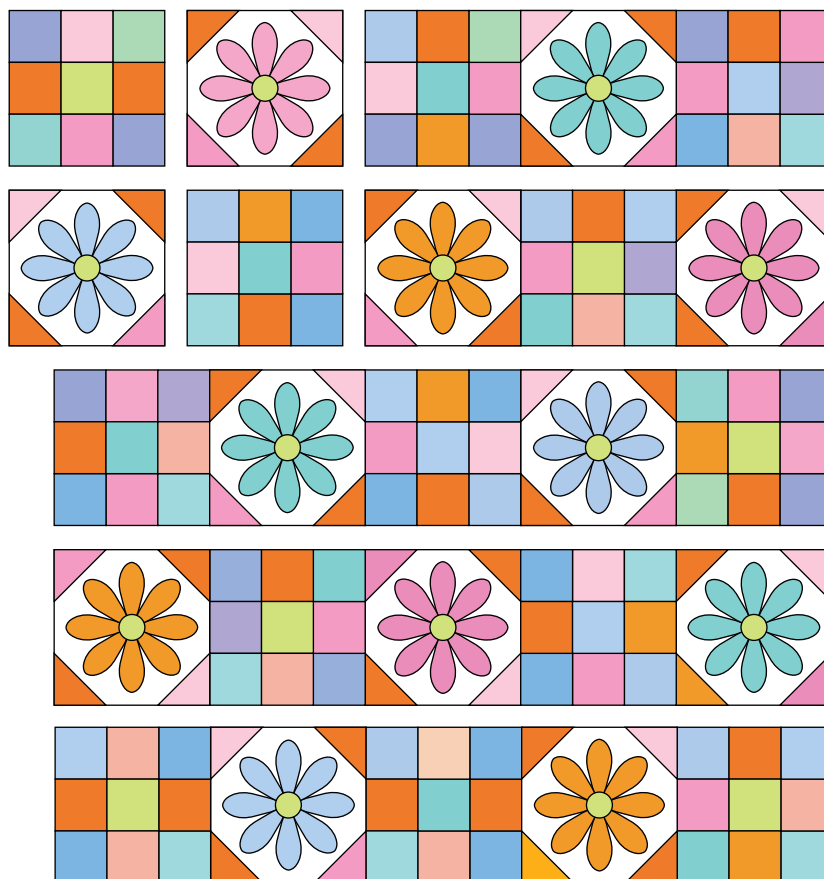

Assembling the Quilt Top

4 **Note:** Refer to the **Assembly Diagram** for this step. Sew 5 rows of 5 blocks each, alternating. Sew rows together.

Quilting and Finishing

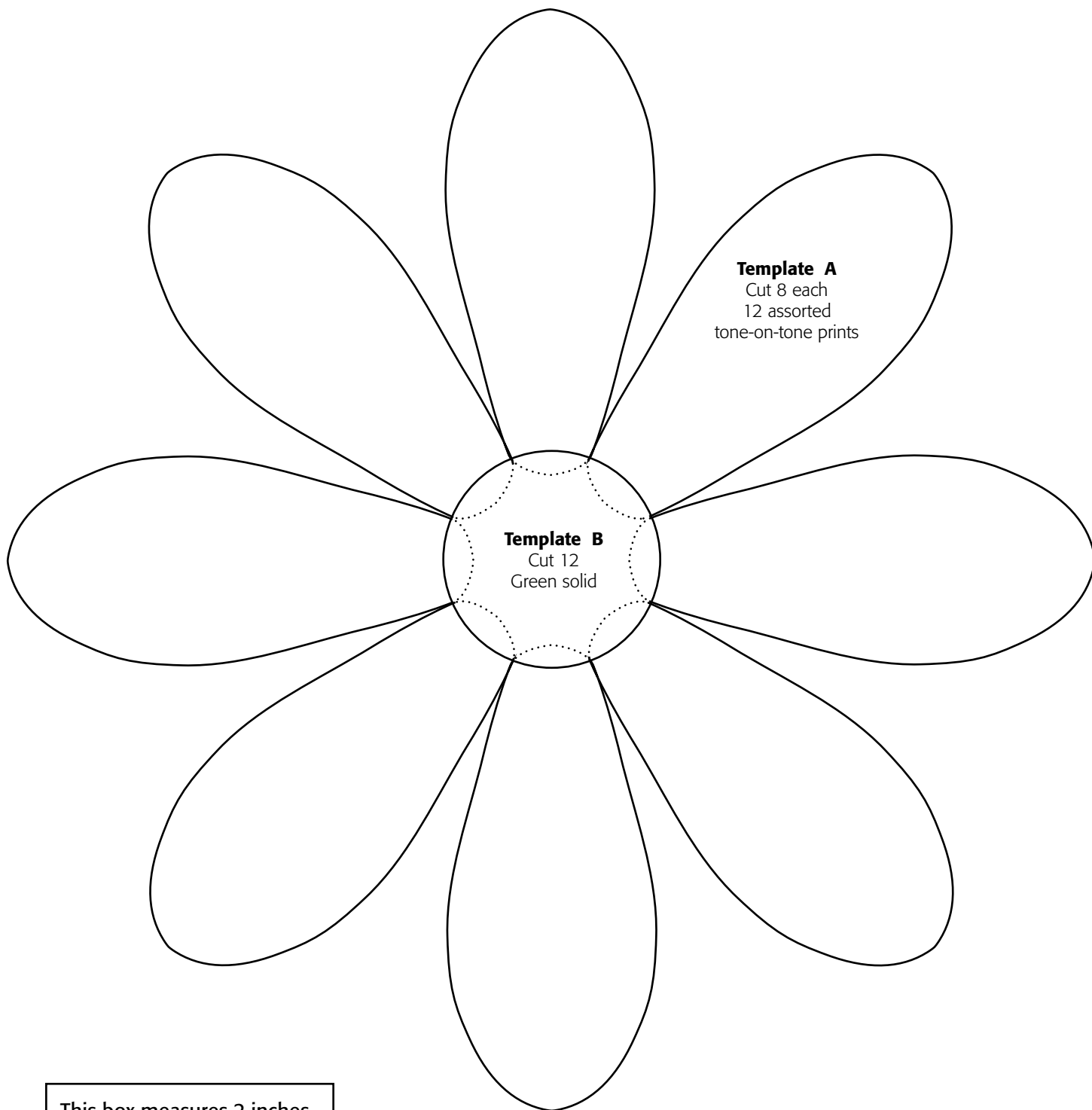
5 Layer, baste, and quilt. Karen machine quilted a bubble and swirl design around the appliqué and a swirl and leaf design in the Nine-Patch Blocks. Bind with green solid.
