# Web Bonus: Ruby Sparkler King Size Quilt

# SKILL LEVEL CONFIDENT BEGINNER

Finished Quilt Size 961/2" x 961/2"

#### Number of Blocks and Finished Size

- 4 Corner Blocks A 24" x 24"
- 4 Edge Blocks B 24" x 24"
- 4 Edge Blocks C 24" x 24"
- 4 Center Blocks D 24" x 24"

#### **Planning**

Simple piecing and four clever block designs come together to create a single radiating star. This quilt would be equally lovely substituting a different favorite color for the red; either way, you'll have a wonderful bed quilt you'll be proud to give or keep. Use an accurate 1/4" seam allowance so all elements of the quilt fit together well.

#### **Fabric Requirements**

Assorted cream/

white prints 71/4-73/4 yds. total

Assorted red/

white prints 41/4-43/4 yds. total

Red/white print

(binding) 1 yd.
Backing 9<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub> yds.
Batting size 106" x 106"

#### **Cutting Instructions**

(cut in order listed)

Assorted cream/white prints—cut a total of:

32 squares 8½" x 8½" 8 rectangles 8½" x 16½" 64 squares 8½" x 8½"


Assorted red/white prints—cut a total of:

32 squares 81/8" x 81/8"

16 rectangles 81/2" x 161/2"

Red/white print

11 strips 2½" x width of fabric (binding)



#### **Piecing the Blocks**

① Draw diagonal line on wrong side of cream/white 87%" square. Referring to Diagram I, place marked square on red/white 87%" square, right sides together. Sew 1/4" seam on each side of marked line; cut apart on marked line. Open and press to make 2 pieced squares. Make 64 total.

2 Draw diagonal line on wrong side of assorted cream 8½" square. Place marked square on assorted red 8½" x 16½" rectangle, right sides together, aligning raw edges (**Diagram II**). Sew on marked line; trim away and discard excess fabric. Repeat on opposite end to make pieced rectangle. Make 16 total.





3 Sew 2 rows using 2 pieced squares and one cream 8½" x 16½" rectangle to make pieced segment (**Diagram III**). Make 8 total.




4 Referring to Diagrams IV-A through IV-D, use cream 8½" squares, pieced squares, pieced segments, and pieced rectangles to assemble blocks A-D in arrangements and quantities shown.





**Note:** Refer to **Assembly Diagram** for following step, watching block placement and orientation.


**5** Arrange and sew 4 rows of 4 blocks.
