## That Cat Halloween Quilt

Finished Quilt Size
$29^{\prime \prime} \times 32$ "
Note: Appliqué templates at end of pattern are printed reversed and without seam allowance to use with paper-backed fusible web.

## Plan

This stylish wall hanging was inspired by an acrylic painting by Donna Mibus (etsy.com/shop/donnamibus). Use the assorted orange Halloween prints to make a spooky, scrappy background for the black kitty! Use solid orange for the small appliqué accents so they really pop.

## Shop

Orange dot (piecing,

8 assorted orange prints/ solids/textures (piecing, appliqué)

1 fat eighth* Black solid (piecing, appliqué) each $3 / 4 \mathrm{yd}$.
Paper-backed fusible web
$7 / 8 \mathrm{yd}$.
Backing
$11 / 8 \mathrm{yds}$.
Batting size
$36^{\prime \prime} \times 38^{\prime \prime}$
*A fat eighth is a 9 " $\times 20-22^{\prime \prime}$ cut of fabric.

## Cut

(in order listed, before cutting appliqué)
Note: Cutting instructions for appliqué
shapes are on templates at end of pattern.
Orange dot
4 strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ width of fabric (WOF) for binding
*4 strips $21 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 34^{\prime \prime}$
2 rectangles $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
2 rectangles $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
4 strips $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 5 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$
10 strips $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
4 strips $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
6 rectangles $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21^{\prime \prime} 2^{\prime \prime}$
4 squares $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
8 assorted orange prints/solids/texturescut a total of:

8 rectangles $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
10 rectangles $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} 2^{\prime \prime}$
13 rectangles $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$


Black solid
8 strips $1^{\prime \prime} \times 251 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
12 strips $1^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
12 strips $1^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
18 strips $1^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
12 rectangles $1^{\prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}}{}$
*Border strips include extra length for trimming.

## Sew

1 Referring to Diagram I, sew together 2 orange dot $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares, 6 black solid $1^{\prime \prime} \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles, and 5 orange dot $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips as shown to make row A. Make 2. Make rows B-D in fabrics and quantities shown, making sure each row starts and ends with orange dot patches.


2 Note: Refer to Assembly Diagram for following steps. Sew rows together, alternating with black solid $1^{\prime \prime} \times 25 \frac{112 " 1}{}$ strips.
3 Sew orange dot $21 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 34^{\prime \prime}$ strips to sides of quilt; trim even with top and bottom. Sew remaining orange dot 34" strips to top/bottom; trim even with sides.



4 Follow manufacturer's instructions for paper-backed fusible web. Trace templates A-E on paper side of fusible web. Cut apart, leaving small margin beyond drawn lines. Fuse to wrong side of appropriate fabrics; cut out on drawn lines. Referring to Quilt Photo and Diagram II-A, arrange A-E in alphabetical order on quilt top. Fuse in place. Edge-stitch using machine blanket stitch and matching thread (Diagram II-B).

5 Layer, baste, and quilt. Bind with orange dot.
